- ❖ Joint Polish & German degree created by BTU (originally by the Hochschule Lausitz) and the University of Applied Sciences in Nysa
- ❖ Two diplomas – Polish & German
- ❖ First steps – thanks to the Socrates /Erasmus Programme 2006
- ❖ Second step – Double Diploma – 2007
- ❖ First mobility – 2008
- ❖ First graduated students – 2011
- ❖ Till now: over 35 students took or taking part in the programme & over 15 graduates students
